

We will be accepting applications through the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS) for the 2009-2010 year beginning on September 1, 2009. If you have not already registered with ERAS, you may receive information regarding that process by calling the Association of American Medical Colleges or visiting their website at www.aamc.org.

Additionally for International Medical Graduates:

ECFMG status report .. applicants must be ECFMG certified.
Letter of recommendation regarding your clinical experience in the United States.- we require 3-6 months of clinical experience

Application Deadline : We require that all documentation and applications be received by January 1, 2009 in order to allow for interviews to be completed by the second week in February, 2009.

Score preferences begin with scores of 80 and above on the first time attempt for Parts I and II of the USMLE exam.

Clinical Experience Requirement: We require 3-6 months of clinical experience in the U.S. for international medical graduates

Graduation Year Requirement: We prefer that applicants are no more than 5 years post graduation from medical school.

Eligibility of Work: This program does not sponsor H1 or J1 Visas.
